### ALAN C ROSE MEMORIAL FUND Terms & Conditions

Alan Rose was founder and managing director of Rose Music Pty Ltd, which was a major contributor to the fund. During his lifetime, Alan Rose made an impressive contribution to the music industry including the provision of financial assistance for music camps and master classes by distinguished musicians.

The purpose of the fund is to assist VCA music students with financing their own special project. The funds could be applied to a range of activities including, but not limited to, performance/research projects, travel to undertake studies with musicians outside of Victoria or ensemble performance. The project can be collaborative and joint applications will be accepted. All projects must have a tangible outcome, such as a performance or CD/DVD recording.

Terms and conditions governing the award of the Award are set out below.

1. The award is entitled the Alan C Rose Memorial Fund Award. At the discretion of the Selection Panel, minor awards may be made.
2. The value of the scholarship in 2008 is up to \$15,000.
3. To be eligible to apply, students must be enrolled in:
  - Year 3, Bachelor of Music Performance
  - Bachelor of Music Performance (Honours)
  - Postgraduate Diploma in Music Performance
  - Master of Music Performance (by Research)
4. Applicants are required to submit the following:
  - A high quality CD/DVD recording of 20 minutes duration;
  - A written proposal detailing the project and addressing the aims and relevance of the project to the individual's professional development;

- A maximum of two professional referees to support the proposal;
  - A detailed budget;
  - Applicants will be required to make a brief presentation to the Selection Committee of no more than 10 minutes
5. The University Council will apply the funds on the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising:
    - David Rose, or any person appointed by him;
    - The Head of VCA Music;
    - Another person nominated by the Head, VCA Music.
  6. When making their decision, the Selection Committee will consider the following criteria:
    - Benefits of the project to the applicant's professional development;
    - The applicants talent and potential;
    - The applicant's likelihood in successfully completing the project.
  7. Every scholarship holder must forward to the Scholarship Administrator a copy of their academic record showing results in all subjects undertaken in the course.
  8. Scholarship monies must be utilised between 1 June 2008 and 30 June 2009.
  9. No scholarship holder during the period of the scholarship shall conduct himself or herself in such manner that the Director, in their absolute discretion, considers prejudicial to the reputation of the VCA or to good order and discipline within the VCA.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary implicit in any of the terms and conditions relating to the scholarship, the Director may on such information as appears satisfactory to her or him determine whether the provisions of these terms and conditions are being complied with and may withhold altogether, or for such period as thought fit, payment of any further instalments of the awards.

If the student to whom the scholarship has been awarded dies before payment of the first instalment, the VCA will be under no liability whatsoever to the estate, but may pay such further amount or amounts to such person or persons as the Director in his or her absolute discretion determines.

The Director may on such information as appears satisfactory

determine whether a scholarship holder has by reason of illness or other cause become incapable of pursuing the course so defined by the scholarship or of taking further advantage thereof (as the case may be). If the Director determines that the holder has become so incapacitated, the VCA shall be under no liability whatever, but may pay such amount or amounts, to any person or persons as she or he in their absolute discretion determines. The exercising of power vested in the VCA under this instrument will be at the Director's absolute discretion.
