AVIARY is a new performance work opening at the Living Museum of the West in Maribyrnong this September. The performance is a VCA Masters of Animateuring research project directed and devised by Louise Morris in collaboration with an ensemble of 30 dynamic physical performers including members of the Red Cabbage collective.

AVIARY invites the audience to meet at a specified location where they will be guided through a site specific and beautifully haunting visual journey which concludes inside the historic bluestone building at the centre of Pipemakers Park.

The narrative is constructed entirely in images (not unlike a silent film) integrating innovative visual and sound design from artists such as Govin Rubin, Evan Granger, Terry Ryan and Lauren Theos.

AVIARY is a truly unique event, a theatrical adventure not to be missed.
