Plump comprises sculptor **Marc Rogerson**, sound artist **Philip Samartzis** and noise guitarist **Dave Brown**, who join to create site-specific installations of kinetic, illuminated sculpture and sound.

Cluster is designed specifically for the VCA Margaret Lawrence Gallery and comprises a number of suspended illuminated pods that are moved by air currents and driven by motion sensor-activated electric fans. As the pods bump and collide against one another, they become percussive instruments. An accompanying soundscape is drawn from both the inherent ambient noise in the gallery itself and various electronic and synthesized sounds.

With **Cluster**, Plump will create an environment wherein received ideas about cause and effect are challenged and the laws of classical physics are suspended.
